Andy Warhol's Myths, a new series of paintings and silkscreen prints, will be exhibited for the first time at Ronald Feldman Fine Arts Downtown on September 12<sup>th</sup>. Included are preliminary drawings and trial proofs of the prints.

The myths Warhol presents are well known. Their roots are in ancient beliefs, folklore, allegorical tales, and are based on traditional stories and media creations. They represent fantasies, dreams, hopes and fears.

Included in the series are: Dracula, Howdy Doody, Mammy, Mickey Mouse, Santa Claus, Superman, The Shadow, The Star, The Witch and Uncle Sam. Most of Warhol's myths are derived from photographs he has taken especially for this series.

The public is invited to the opening on Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. The gallery is open Tuesday through Saturday, 10:30 am to 6:00 pm. Admission is free.
