The Feldman Gallery will present FACE↻OFF, a contemporary group exhibition that takes an unexpected approach to the current political moment. Timed to coincide with the national elections, FACE↻OFF responds to the growing atmosphere of anger and anxiety which has begun to define our lives, times, and political discourse.

FACE↻OFF offers a varied presentation of individual concerns. Despite the combative stance suggested by the title, the critiques presented in FACE↻OFF range from the oblique to the specific. What emerges is a meditation on various subjects in a wide variety of media, including textiles, watercolor, sculpture, audio, and video. The artworks express frustration, protest, humor, and concern for the future, and invite or provoke the viewers to a face off of their own.
